# SAINTS AND OBSERVANCES

## 19 AUG (Friday): SAINT LOUIS, Bishop (1274-1297)

Born to the nobility, Louis was the son of Charles II of Anjou, king of Naples, and great-nephew of Saint Louis IX, and of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary. He spent seven years as a hostage for his father at Barcelona and Tarragona in Spain. Louis was ordained at age 23, and became the reluctant bishop of Toulouse, France for the last six months of his life.

## SAINT JOHN EUDES, Priest (1601-1680)

John worked with plague victims in France, and later formed the *Congregation of Jesus and Mary Eudists* and the *Sisters of Our Lady of Charity*. He authored the liturgical devotion to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary.

## 20 AUG (Saturday): SAINT BERNARD, Abbot and Doctor of the Church (1894-1941)

Fearing the ways of the world, **Bernard of Clairvaux**, along with four of his brothers and 25 friends, joined the abbey of Citeaux. Their father and another brother joined shortly after. He founded and led the monastery of Clairvaux, which soon had 700 monks and 160 daughter houses. He is the first Cistercian monk to be placed on the calendar of saints.

### NATIVITY SCHOOL OF RELIGION: 2016-2017

Registration has begun for Nativity's **Children's Faith Formation Program**. Children who attend public or independent schools in 1st through 8th grades should be enrolled in Nativity's School of Religion for ongoing faith formation. Registration forms and information packets are available online ([nativitymenlo.org](http://nativitymenlo.org)) under the *School of Religion* link. A kick-off celebration will be held on **18 SEP 2016**, Catechetical Sunday, after the **09:30 AM** Mass. Classes begin on **Sunday, 25 SEP 2016**. We encourage all children to continue on in the School of Religion after receiving First Communion, through all grade levels until the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Mrs. Hickam will be available after Masses on **13-14, 20-21** and **27-28 AUG 2016** to register your children and answer any questions about the program. Sacrament Class and Classes for grades 1 to 6 are held on **Sundays** from **08:15-09:15 AM** at Nativity School and continue on into our **09:30 AM** Mass with our *Children's Liturgy of the Word*. Confirmation Preparation Classes are held on **Wednesday** evenings from **07:00-08:00 PM** in the O'Hare Center beginning **05 OCT 2016**.

**First Reconciliation/First Holy Communion** requires 2 years of instruction before a child is eligible to receive these Sacraments. Children should be enrolled in 1st grade.

**Confirmation Preparation** is also a 2-year program as required by the Archdiocese of San Francisco. Children should be enrolled as they enter 7th grade, but will include older students who have not yet been confirmed.

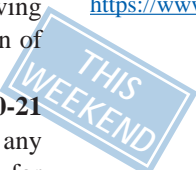
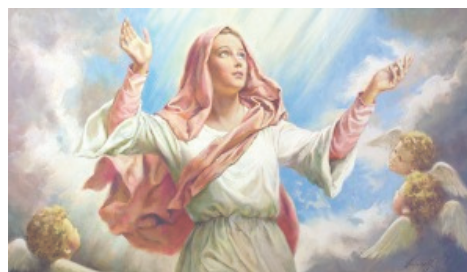

### PRAYERS AFTER COMMUNION

What do you do when you return to the pew after receiving Holy Communion? If you're reading the back of the bulletin anyway, read these! These prayers come from the **1962 edition of My Sunday Missal**:

#### Prayer Before a Crucifix (also imparts a Plenary Indulgence if recited after Communion)

O good and dearest Jesus, before Thy face I humbly kneel, and with the most fervent desire of my soul I pray and beseech Thee to fix deep in my heart lively sentiments of faith, hope and charity, true sorrow for my sins and a firm purpose of amendment, whilst with deep affection and grief of soul I reflect upon and ponder over Thy five most Precious Wounds, having before my eyes the words of David the prophet concerning Thee, my Jesus: **"They have pierced My hands and My feet, they have numbered all my bones."** *Our Father, ... Hail, Mary, ... Glory Be ...* (for the Holy Father's intentions).

#### What Shall I Give Thee?

I have received into my heart Jesus Christ, His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. I begin this day, as a day in Heaven. He is in my soul the Divine Infant in the crib, the growing Boy at Nazareth, the Apostle acclaimed by the crowds on the roads of Galilee, the Miracle-Worker Who performed such prodigies, the Martyr Who completed His Sacrifice on Calvary.

And now, O good Master, what shall I give Thee in exchange for Thy visit ... ? I would like to pray to Thee with the burning words of Thy Mother and her court of Heaven, but I feel riveted to earthly things ... I would like to offer Thee courageous loyalty to my Baptismal Vows and Confirmation Graces but alas, I have so often been disloyal ... I would like, at least, to have a desire for the Christian life, but I allow myself to be discouraged by my failures ... O good Jesus, I have nothing to give Thee, and Thou hast given Everything; Thou hast given Thyself to me. I can only join my poor voice in the chorus of praise to Thee, rising out of all the works of Thy Creation here on earth ... With fifteen hundred millions now living on earth, *I shall praise Thy Mercy!* May our voices unite with the billions of those who inhabited the earth before us, and out of whose dust the beauty of Nature perpetually rises to praise Thy Glory! May an infinite concert of voices from cottages and palaces, from fields and forests, from towns and deserts, from workshops and cathedrals, from earth and from heaven, from time and from eternity, arise to give my thanks unto Thee. Amen.
