## SAINTS AND OBSERVA

#### 04 SEP (Monday): **LABOR DAY**

On 05 September 1882, the first Labor Day parade was held in New York City. Twenty thousand workers marched in a parade up Broadway. They carried banners that read LABOR CREATES ALL WEALTH and EIGHT HOURS FOR WORK, EIGHT HOURS FOR REST, EIGHT HOURS FOR RECREATION! After the parade there were picnics all around the city. At night, fireworks were set off. Within the next few years, the idea spread from coast to coast, and all states celebrated Labor Day. In 1894, Congress voted it a federal holiday.

08 SEP (Friday): THE NATIVITY OF THE **BLESSED VIRGIN MARY** 



#### 09 SEP (Saturday): **SAINT PETER CLAVER, Priest** (1581-1654)

A Jesuit missionary to America, Peter ministered physically and spiritually to the slaves when they arrived in Cartegena. He reportedly converted 300,000, and worked for humane treatment on the plantations for 40 years. He organized charitable societies among the Spanish in America similar to those in Europe by St. Vincent de Paul.

Registration has begun for Nativity's **Children's Faith Formation Program**. Children who attend public or independent schools in 1st through 8th grades should be enrolled in Nativity's School of Religion for ongoing faith formation.

Registration forms and information packets are available online (www.nativitymenlo.org) under the *School of Religion* link. We encourage all children to continue on in the School of Religion after receiving First Communion, through all grade levels until the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Mrs. Hickam will be available after Masses on **09-10 SEP 2017** to register your children and answer any questions about the program. **Sacrament Class** and **Classes for grades 1-6** are held on **Sundays** from **08:15-09:15 AM** at Nativity School and continue on into our **09:30 AM** Mass with our *Children's Liturgy of the Word* (beginning **24 SEP 2017**) Confirmation Preparation Classes are held on **Wednesday** evenings from **07:00-08:00 PM** in the O'Hare Center beginning **11 OCT 2017**.

**First Reconciliation/First Holy Communion** requires 2 years of instruction before a child is eligible to receive these Sacraments. Children should be enrolled in 1st grade.

**Confirmation Preparation** is also a 2-year program as required by the Archdiocese of San Francisco. Children should be enrolled as they enter 7th grade, but will include older students who have not yet been confirmed.

A kick-off celebration will be held on 17 SEP 2017 (Catechetical Sunday), after the 09:30AM Mass. Classes begin on Sunday, 24 SEP 2017 and the Confirmation Classes begin on 11 OCT 2017.

#### **RCIA FOR 2017-18 BEGINS IN SEPTEMBER**



400 KNOW?

Spending time with our Lord in a Holy Hour has benefits of which most of us are not aware:

 Our Lord revealed to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque how to make a Holy Hour. In 1674,

Our Lord appeared to her and complained of the indifference with which mankind treated His Love for them and asked her to make atonement for this ingratitude. He said: "I will make you a partaker of that sorrow unto death which it was My will to suffer in the Garden of Olives. To join with Me in the humble prayer which I then offered to My Divine Father in agony, you shall rise before midnight, and remain with Me upon your knees prostrate for one hour, with your face to the ground, to appease the anger of My Eternal Father and ask of Him pardon for sinners."

- In an Apostolic Letter on 30 MAR 1886, Pope Leo XIII allowed the faithful to make their Holy Hour on any hour and day of the week.
- "Every Holy Hour we make so pleases the Heart of Jesus that it is recorded in Heaven and retold for all eternity!" --Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta
- Our Lord revealed to **Blessed Dina Belanger** that a Holy Hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament is so important that "a multitude of souls go to heaven that had been destined for hell".
- "You can come to Me (in Eucharistic Adoration) at any moment, at any time; I want to speak to you and I desire to grant you grace." -- Our Lord to Saint Faustina
