
SOLEMNITY FEAST MEMORIAL + OPTIONAL MEMORIAL + OTHER

06 FEB (Wednesday): SAINTS PAUL MIKI and COMPANIONS, Martyrs (d. 1597)

Paul, the son of a Japanese military leader, joined the Jesuits in 1580, and became known for his eloquent preaching. He was crucified with 25 other Japanese Catholics (the Martyrs of Nagasaki), mostly laymen, during the persecution of Christians under the Taiko, Toyotomi Hideyoshi, ruler of Japan in the name of the emperor. Paul delivered his final sermon from the cross.

10 FEB (Saturday): SAINT SCHOLASTICA, Virgin (480-543)

Twin sister of **St. Benedict**. After Benedict founded the monastery of Monte Cassino, Scholastica founded a community of nuns nearby, leading an exemplary life.




